❖ Meeting called to order at 2:55 pm

❖ Block Grant:

- ✓ Funds need to be dispersed according to our school plan.
- ✓ Music department is requesting funds to replace current pianos with 2 electric digital pianos @ \$579 each, one deck of risers @ \$500-\$700, 25 music stands @ \$55 each, a rack for the stands, 15 chairs @ \$70 each, funds for instrument repair, and funds for more instruments.
 - Money for these items may come from block grant funds or from the fine arts grant.
- ✓ Parameters for spending of block grant funds were gone over again, and suggestions for ways to spend the funds were discussed:
 - Release days for faculty to write WASC reports and research.
 - Interventions for benchmark and CST data...
 - Math department would like \$12,000 for the year for two teachers to tutor after school for one hour Monday through Thursday.
 - The English and Science departments would like to do something similar.
 - ✘ CONCERNS: Will students show up? This will only solve a problem for the next year— shouldn't we spend our \$ on something that will have a more lasting affect? Other options were discussed for solving this problem.
- ✓ PRIORITIES FOR SPENDING OF FUNDS
 - Intervention for students who are struggling—needs to be comprehensive

- *Technology: replacing LCD bulbs, purchase of more LCD projectors, more copy machines, collator machine, mount LCDs in the ceiling*
- *Building improvements*
- *More dictionaries*
- *Think about...using money for consultant fees and testing supplies*
- *Motion approved to utilize the \$108,945 in Block Grant funds for the items listed on the following page.*
- ❖ *Motion to approve the funds for the new server for the library; up to \$2400 out of SIP funds was approved.*
- ❖ *WASC: we have the results of the faculty survey, scores on standardized tests, school and community profile, and CST scores (numbers are percentages) to go over in focus groups to determine critical school-wide needs for use of block grant funds. Meeting will be Monday, 5 March 2007 right after school.*
