- Asian Pacific Fund Banatao Scholarship** - Those 12th grade students who will be pursuing an engineering, computer, or physical science major at a 4 year college in the Fall of 2007. Applicants must be of Filipino descent (at least 50%) and have a GPA of 3.0 or above.
Amount: \$5,000 renewable for 4 yrs. Deadline: February 9, 2007 Where: Applications in Guidance
- California Association of Collectors Educational Scholarship** - Those 12th grade students who will be attending a 2 yr. or 4 yr. college or vocational school in the Fall of 2007.
